#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- Age: At least 60 years of age OR
- 0 to age 6, not participating in the WIC program
- Pregnancy and nursing women eligible but not receiving WIC
- Income Requirements:
  - Seniors: Household monthly income: 1 person: \$1,180  
2 persons: \$1,594  
3 persons: \$2,008
  - Children: Household monthly income: (no one person allowed)  
2 persons: \$2,268  
3 persons: \$2,857  
4 persons: \$3,446  
5 persons: \$4,035

To sign up bring:

- Proof of income, at least one of the following:
  1. Check Stub: SSI, SS, Pension, Employment
  2. Bank Statement
  3. AFDC / TANF Documentation
  4. Medi-Cal card
- Proof of age:
  1. Seniors: Driver License, State ID Card, Medi-Cal or Medicare Card
  2. Children: Birth Certificate, Medi-Cal card, Immunization Record

This program provides 30 – 40 pounds of food per individual.
