Resource Family Recruitment



Lake County Probation has teamed up with Child Welfare Services, Redwood Community Services, and EA Family Services to find Resource Families within Lake County

Due to the limited amount of local Resource Families

90% of Probation youth are placed out of the county.



On average, they are placed 3-5 hours away from their home.



The distance makes reunification efforts and educational opportunities harder to provide. Probation believes these youth to be resilient, creative, and motivated to reach adulthood with some independent living skills. It only takes one caring adult to make a difference in a youth's life. VAPE PENS?!



Everyone knows smoking kills. But what about Vaping? Vape pens are becoming increasingly popular among youth in the community. But are they safe? Here are some facts, and Probation's opinion.

A standard vaporizer has three components:

- I. A liquid cartridge called E-liquid used to produce the vapor (This is often flavored and can contain high amounts of nicotine)
- II. A heating element known as the atomizer
- III. A rechargeable battery to power the atomizer



DANGERS

- ⇒ Nicotine is a drug that contributes to heart disease
- ⇒ Vape pens contain formaldehyde, silicate particles and metals linked to causing lung disease
- ⇒ Long term health effects include respiratory problems, gastrointestinal conditions and nicotine poisoning
