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Commercial Agricultural Business Verification for Lake County Restricted Access Program

Program Overview

The Lake County Department of Agriculture, Lake County Community Development Department, Lake County Office of Emergency Services and the Lake County Sheriff's Office, have worked in partnership to establish a restricted access program. The program is to assist commercial agricultural producers, growers and ranchers in completing critical work during restricted access orders to reduce significant production loss to the commercial agricultural business and the County of Lake.

The purpose of this form is to obtain commercial agricultural verification prior to a restricted access order which will in most cases expedite the critical need verification and issuance of a restricted access permit. It is strongly recommended that this be completed prior to an event.

Commercial Agriculture Qualifiers for Verification.

- Pears: Operator must hold a current and valid spray permit
- Wine grapes: Operator must hold a current and valid spray permit OR produce greater than 25 tons of fruit annually
- Walnuts: Operator must farm 10 acres AND either hold a current and valid spray permit or irrigate their crop
- Hemp: Must have a current and valid County and State Registration
- Wineries: Licensed and insured business.
- Cattle: 30 head OR licensed/insured business
- Goats/Sheep: 50 head OR licensed/insured business
- Bees: Registered with Lake County Ag Department in CDFA's Apiary Registration Program (BeeWhere), with a minimum of 100 hives.
- Equine: Must be equine boarding facility possessing insurance and equine boarding license from Lake County Community Development

Any person with less than the above stated number of livestock are advised to contact Lake County Animal Care and Control or Lake Evacuation & Animal Protection (LEAP) during a Restricted Access or order to assistance with the care of livestock.

Important: It is your responsibility to keep your information updated. Failure to do so may result in the delay of issuance of a restricted access permit.
